With an expanding cut flower garden and plenty of greenery and grasses to harvest from, we are uniquely placed to offer in-house fresh florals that are organically grown and harvested within just a day or two prior to your wedding - so they are truly fresh!

Of course, this means that we may have to buy in some flowers to meet your specific requirements, but if you are open to simply a beautiful array of natural blooms and greenery for your special day, then it's quite possible to minimise the need for bought-in florals.

But we are totally understanding that you may be dreaming of peaonies, which unfortunately we can't grow here. So we are happy to liaise with you to find the perfect combination of bought-in and/or fresh-harvested florals for your wedding, and to source them as locally as possible.

Bride's Hand-Tied Bouquet

With a minimum of 40 stems, Bride's bouquets start at just £40.00

The only time this cost will go up is if we need to buy in specialist flowers and this will be discussed prior to placing your deposit so that you can feel completely happy with your quote before committing to go ahead.

This spring-wedding bouquet is made up of freshharvested eucalyptus, buttercups, laurel shoots and grasses, with bought-in roses, chrysanthemums and freesias. The matching bridesmaids' posies (below) had additional pops of colourful carnations.

Bridesmaid's Hand-Tied Posy

A smaller version of the Bride's bouquet, Bridesmaids' posies start from £27.50 and are subject to the same conditions noted above for the Bride's bouquet.



Groomsmen's Bouttonieres

While we prefer to offer the pocket-style bouttonnieres as they are much easier to keep fresh, lapel pins are an option as well. Both options are £15.00 per bouttonniere.

You will receive them as small posies in mini aquapacks to keep them hybrated until gotime, and if you opted for the pocket-style boutonnieres you will also get the pockets made-up and ready to receive them.

Table Posies

At just £5.50 each, these are a simple and beautiful way to dress up your tables without being too imposing, and your guests can take the flowers home if they like!

We provide recycled honey/jam glass jars for this purpose which you can customise as you wish, and fill them with fresh flowers and greenery from your selection to make attractive and colourful table decorations. If you have your own jars/vases/containers you would like us to use, feel free to let us know:)

Mini Alpine Gardens + Bedding Plants in Pottery

Whether you opt for small terracotta pots or recycled pottery, which we have plenty of or you can supply yourself, these adorable desk-top succulent gardens and flowers are always a winner when given as gifts! Once the plants have been potted on, the pottery can be reused, making for a lasting and very eco-friendly wedding favour option.

Other Potted Gift Options

Potted into nursery pots or self-supplied pots

Tip: Nursery pots are what we refer to when speaking of basic, soft plastic pots that we sell our bedding and veg plants in. They are usually made of recycled plastic and are often recyclable as well. See the Quote Generator for full list of prices for each option. And remember, you are welcome to mix and match the options for your guests, as each is priced individually 😉

Succulents: These are a great option if you want to keep costs low but still make a splash. Our succulent plants are very easy to care for, grow quickly in the warm months, take very little watering or care and can be planted into a well-drained spot in the garden.

Bedding Plants: Abundant annuals are a cost-effective and short-term-commitment option as they last only for a season.

Potted Bulbs: These are great if you have a specific flower in mind (eg daffodils) and you want to gift your guests one to take home. They are only available at certain times depending on the variety.

Perennials: An ideal option if you have gardening enthusiasts in your wedding party! These are a long-term, return-each-year option and there are a huge variety to choose from.

Tree Saplings: Do your guests have space to plant a tree? Talk about the ultimate long-term gift (both for your guests and the environment)! The options are limited here as some tree seeds take a long time to germinate, but we can chat about it if you are incrested.

Potted Herbs: For your foodie friends and family! Nursery grown herbs way out-last the poor things sold in supermarkets and you can opt for unusual herbs like lemon balm or chervil which are not readily available elsewhere.





While some folks love to DIY everything, others may not want to, be able to, or have time to. That's where this service comes in. We can help as much or as little as you need, however the cost for this service is a fixed fee.

Examples of how we can be of help to you:

- ~ Contacting suppliers and service providers
 - ~ Sourcing materials and supplies
- ~ Organising elements such as itinerary or seating charts
 - ~ Discussing your vision and how it can be achieved
- ~ Design & creation of invitations, thank you cards and other elements
 - ~ Assisting with budget management
- ~ Coordinating elements and timing on the day, such as catering or games
 - ~ Organising transportation and guest accommodation
 - ~ Sourcing the perfect gifts for the bridal party
 - ~ Trouble-shooting hiccups as they crop up
 - ~ And anything else you may need!

As a seasoned event organiser, Tam is no stranger to wrangling various schedules, organising multiple vendors and suppliers and ensuring that all the last-minute details are taken care of. She is also highly creative and happy to help with any design elements or creation of things like seating chart boards and place cards.

If you live further afield or have a very busy work schedule that leaves you little time for all the many small tasks required to organise a successful day, this service may be particularly useful to you. We can even take photos or videos of prospective suppliers or service providers' products to send you, and keep you in the loop with weekly updates (which increase in frequency in the month before the wedding).

At every step and stage you'll have total control - nothing will be secured without your definitive sign-off. Our highest priority is ensuring that you get exactly what you want, or the closest thing possible!





Offered separately so that you can choose to have help only on the take-down day if you wish, these services are especially suited to you if you have a lot going on before the wedding (like a full docket of hair, make up and mani-pedi's!) or you are skipping straight off on honeymoon after the reception.

As our marquees and lights are included in the hire fee, we will set these up 2 days prior to the wedding, ready to be fully decorated on the day before from as early as 9am. Then you can either have at it and do the rest yourself, or we can take care of it all for you:)

Set-Up Service

- Lay out tables and chairs in your designated configuration, and lay them with linens, favours, place cards, flowers etc.
- Set up your photobooth, buffet tables, drinks tables or any other elements you are having on the day
- Decorate the marquees with any materials you have sourced or supplied
- Put up signage eg Itinerary board, seating chart etc.
- Anything else required!

Take-Down Service

Essentially the reverse of the set-up service, we will ensure that everything is carefully cleaned and packed up for you to collect or to return to suppliers if you have rented any items, and that all refuse is cleared away.





We offer a few options for your wedding bar, assuming you don't intend to hire a mobile bar, which can be a brilliant, though potentially costly, option. However, we have a few listed in the Resources pack should you be looking for that 😌

Supply Only

With this option we stock the Container Bar with locally brewed IPA beer on tap, bottled stout, lager and cider, red, white and rose wine, prosecco, vodka, rum, gin, whiskey, soft drinks and mixers, as well as hot drinks.

If you choose this option, your guests will be served from the Container, and no tabs will be allowed. However, anyone may put an amount of money down at the bar and we will keep a careful tally of their orders and return any unused money at the end of the night.



Waited Service

If you would like for your guests to be served, and have their drinks orders taken by us at the tables, then please select both the Supply Only service and the Waited Service on the Quote Generator Sheet.

With this option, you are welcome to supply champagne or any type of bubbly and we'll have it ready to serve to your guests after the ceremony if you are having one here, or on arrival if you are having your reception here. We would also be happy to source the bubbly of your choice on your behalf at the relevant additional cost.

Self-Supplied Service

The best value option that allows you total control and freedom of choice of what drinks you have available (and allows your guests to contribute to the wedding in that way if you'd like) is to hire our brilliant DIY'ed drinks chest!

A large 270L outdoor storage chest carefully insulated with silver bubble-wrap to ensure that your bags of ice stay frozen and keep your drinks nicely-chilled, was our solution to a lack of refrigeration for our first ever wedding couple. And it worked brilliantly, and with no power required.

It held a significant number of bottles of drinks, 2L bottles of soft drinks, and cans of beer and cider, and took only 10 bags of ice to keep it all cold throughout the hot day and well into the evening. In fact it worked so well, that the next morning when we emptied it, the ice was still mostly frozen.







We personally LOVE a good fire night! And there's nothing so magical as an evening under the stars with bright flames and glowing embers as dusk settles over the land. Not to mention that even in the warmest months, the evenings can be chilly up here in the mountains! So, do we recommend you have the fire pit? Yes. Yes we do.

We have a large 100cm metal fire pit with guard surround and a spark-guard lid, so not only can you have a BIG fire to keep you and your guests cosy, it is also the safest one we could find without having to build a permanent site which we aren't quite sure of yet.

Unfortunately we don't have a photo of it in use, as our latest wedding couple couldn't have it due to the excessive dry weather we had in the weeks prior to their wedding :(

But we do have this really bad shopped image of it in a photo of the set up for their wedding - yes you may laugh as much as you want. We still are!



S'mores Kit

We also offer a s'more kit - a big box full of giant marshmallows, different types of chocolate biscuits (including a gluten-free option if you need it), extra long wood skewers and paper plates. Can't beat it for late evening munchies when it's been a few hours since the meal and the drinks have been flowing freely!



Now that you have a good idea of what the additional services we offer entail, the next steps for you would be to complete our Quote Generator form by visiting events.dnsinc.online.

It's very easy to use - just add your relevant information, and then input the quantity of any and all services you require in the boxes. This will automatically give you the subtotal for each item to the right, as well as the grand total at the bottom of the sheet. So you can play around with the numbers to your heart's content, and when you are happy with the total, just hit "send email" and it will be zipped over to us.

Your total figure is not likely to go up once you have decided on what you are including unless your number of guests go up or additional requirements become necessary, but if you have any concerns just email us, send us a whatsapp or give us a call.

Once you have sent off your quote form, please also send us an email at events@ystwythgcn.com with as much relevant information as you can regarding your requirements and wishes for the day, and anything else you feel would be helpful information to include (such as a Pinterest board you are collecting ideas on).

Once you have done that we can arrange for you to have a visit and consultation, which is completely free of charge, and we can also do this via Whatsapp video if you live further afield and can't get to us easily, or are booking things last-minute and need to expedite the process!

Information regarding deposit and balance payments and when they will be required are detailed in our Terms & Conditions document that you should also have received/downloaded, so please make sure you have read and understood that before submitting your quote.
